DIRECTIVE INSTRUCTING THE DISPENSING OF IMMUTIDES TO ALL PATIENTS IN TB HOSPITALS IN THE NMBHD

BACKGROUND

Immutides Spray is a non-scheduled, natural product, produced from bovine colostrum. It contains Proline-Rich Polypeptides that accelerate the maturation of CD 4 Lymphocytes in the Thymus and thereby increasing the patients CD 4 count. This in turn leads to a stronger immune system.

This directive serves to instruct the launch of three projects:

Project 1:

Immutides spray must be dispensed to all patients in the 3 TB hospitals of the NMBHD and any new patients admitted there-after, starting from **01 March 2014**.

All these patients must stay on Immutides Spray for the duration of their TB treatment. On discharge from the hospital they must be issued with a script for Immutides Spray from the doctor at the hospital. The clinics will then provide the Immutides Spray for the remainder of their TB treatment.

The goal is to boost the immune system of patients, so badly affected by TB that they needed admission to hospital.



The hospitals and Pharmaceutical depot must please prepare for this project and order the Immutides Spray so that their pharmacies are ready for roll out on 01/03/2013.

Project 2:

A research project must be launched that will evaluate the effect of adding Immutides Spray to the treatment regime of all TB patients admitted to a TB hospital.

This research project must run for **6 months**, starting from 01/03/2014 up to 31/08/2014. The final written report must be ready for presentation on 31/10/2014.

Project3:

During November 2014, the research report will be evaluated by the Top Management of the NMBHD and the future use of Immutides Spray will be evaluated.


Please note:
