REQUEST FOR THE STATE SECURITY AGENCY TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGED INFORMATION SECURITY BREACH AT THE NATIONAL LOTTERIES COMMISSION

The National Lotteries Commission was established in accordance with the Lotteries Act 57 of 1997, as amended and is a Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) schedule 3A entity. The NLC's primary mandate is to ensure that the National Lottery and sports pools are conducted with all due propriety and strictly in accordance with the Constitution as well as administer and provide funding for good causes.

The NLC has noted with grave concern possible information security breaches and the unauthorized use and/or dissemination of confidential information obtained as a result of performing official functions in the Commission by NLC employees. The activities are intended to undermine the integrity of the Commission, while disrupting the effective functions and causing insurmountable reputational harm to the Commission as the custodian of personal information entrusted to it by its beneficiaries.

it is for this reason that I hereby request that South African State Security Agency provide urgent assistance through the investigation of possible information security breaches and sabotage of NLC operations.





Elimination of this complex risk will ensure that the NLC is sustainable and continues to function efficiently and effectively to ensure a sustainable and effective operations of the NLC, whilst protecting the national asset, being the National Lottery and National Lottery Distribution Trust Fund
