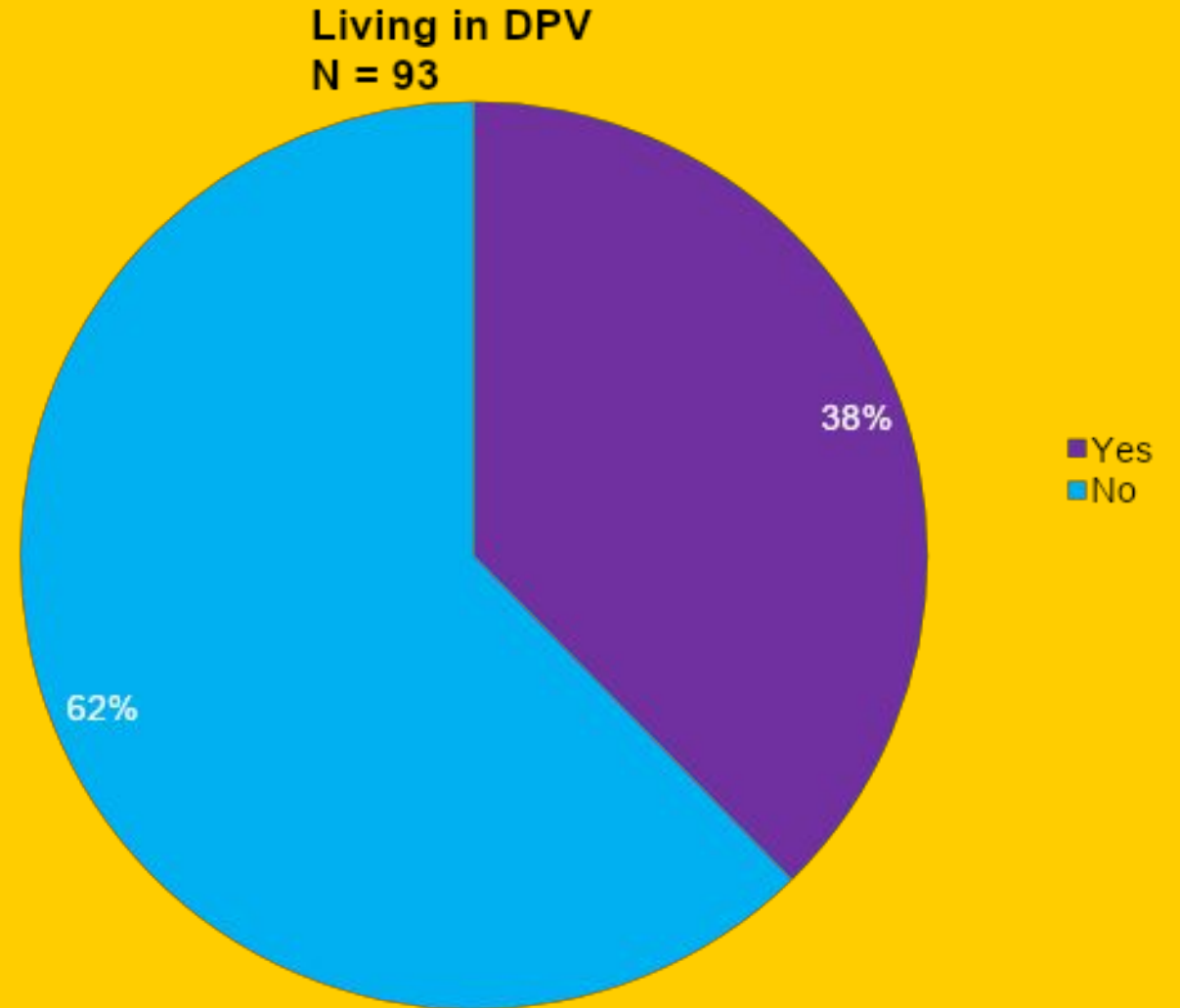

Out of everyone interviewed in Ward 77, 35 live in DPV.

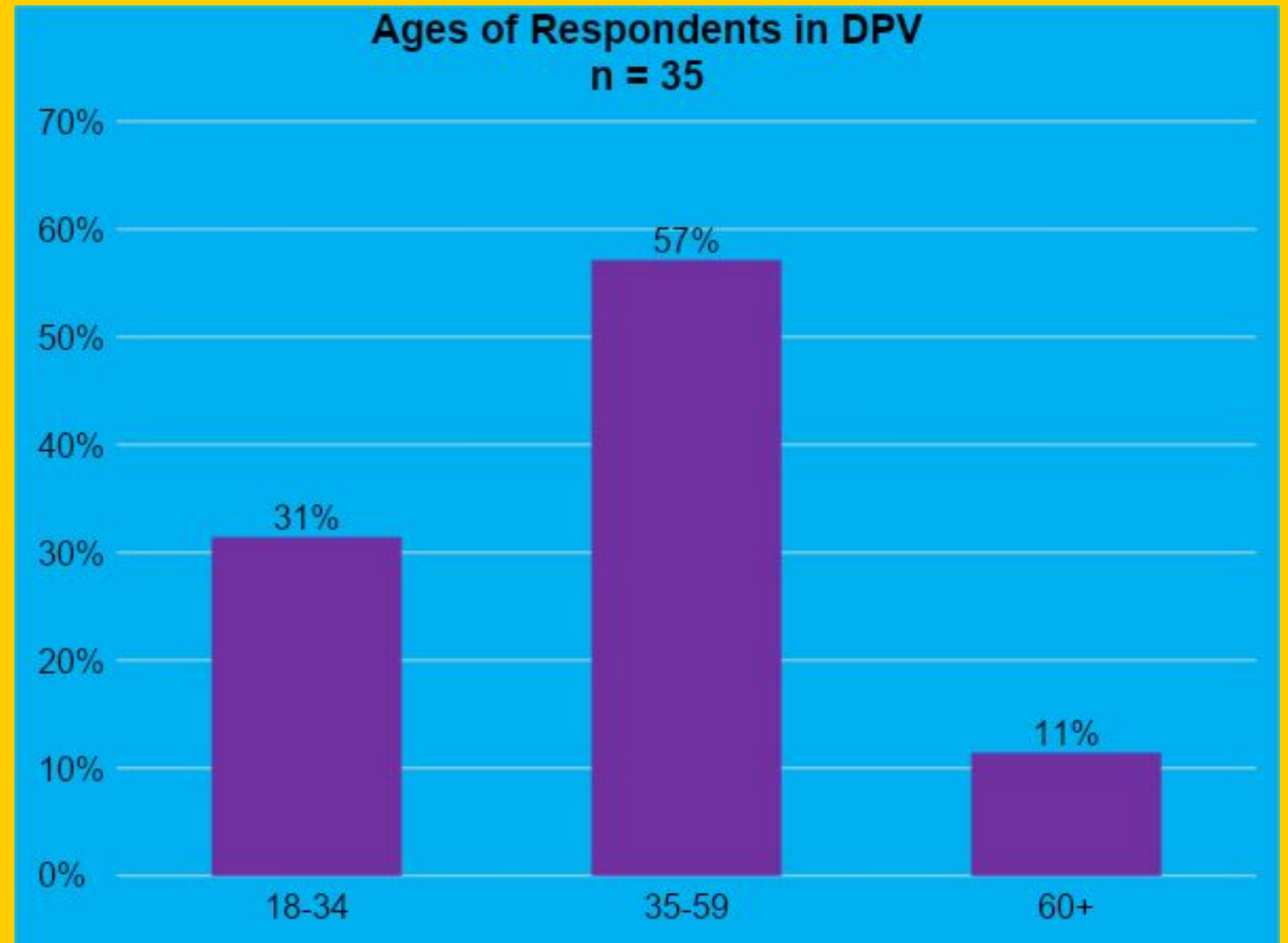


AGE

neighbours in DPV:

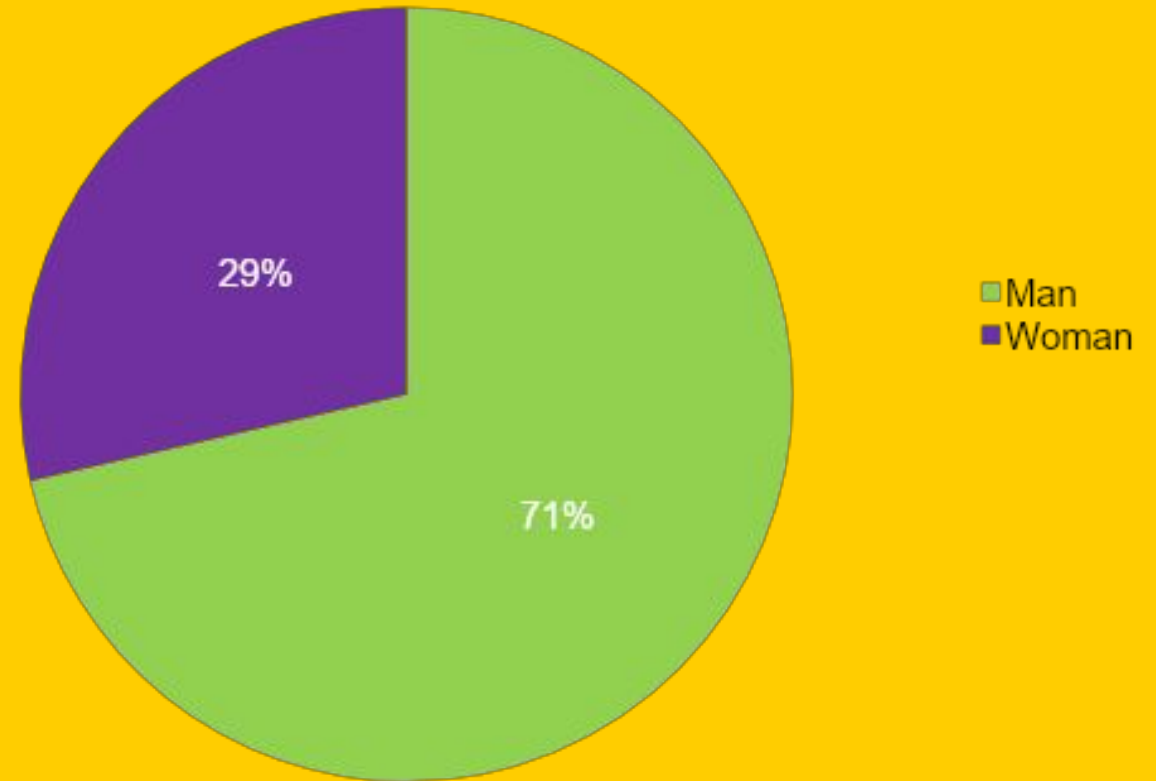
4 are pensioners

n = 35

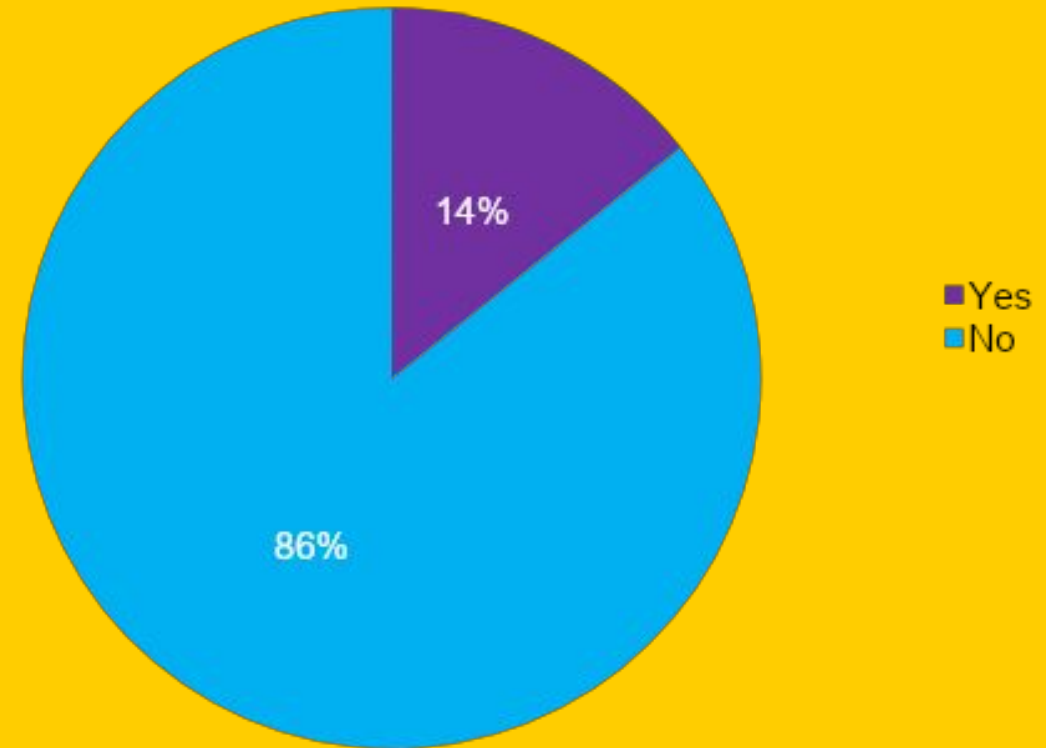


DISABILITY

- “Cripple”

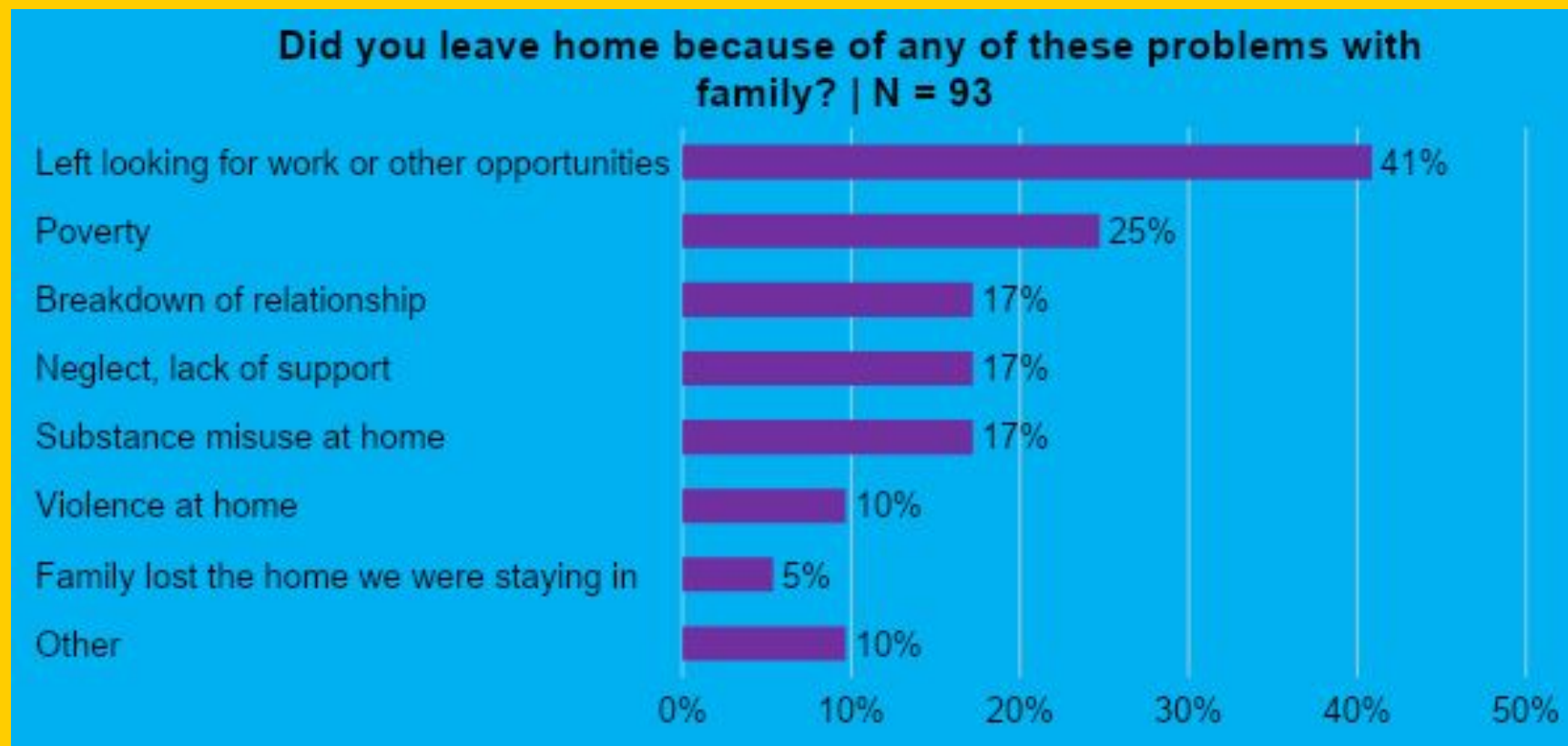
Disability Status of Respondents in DPV

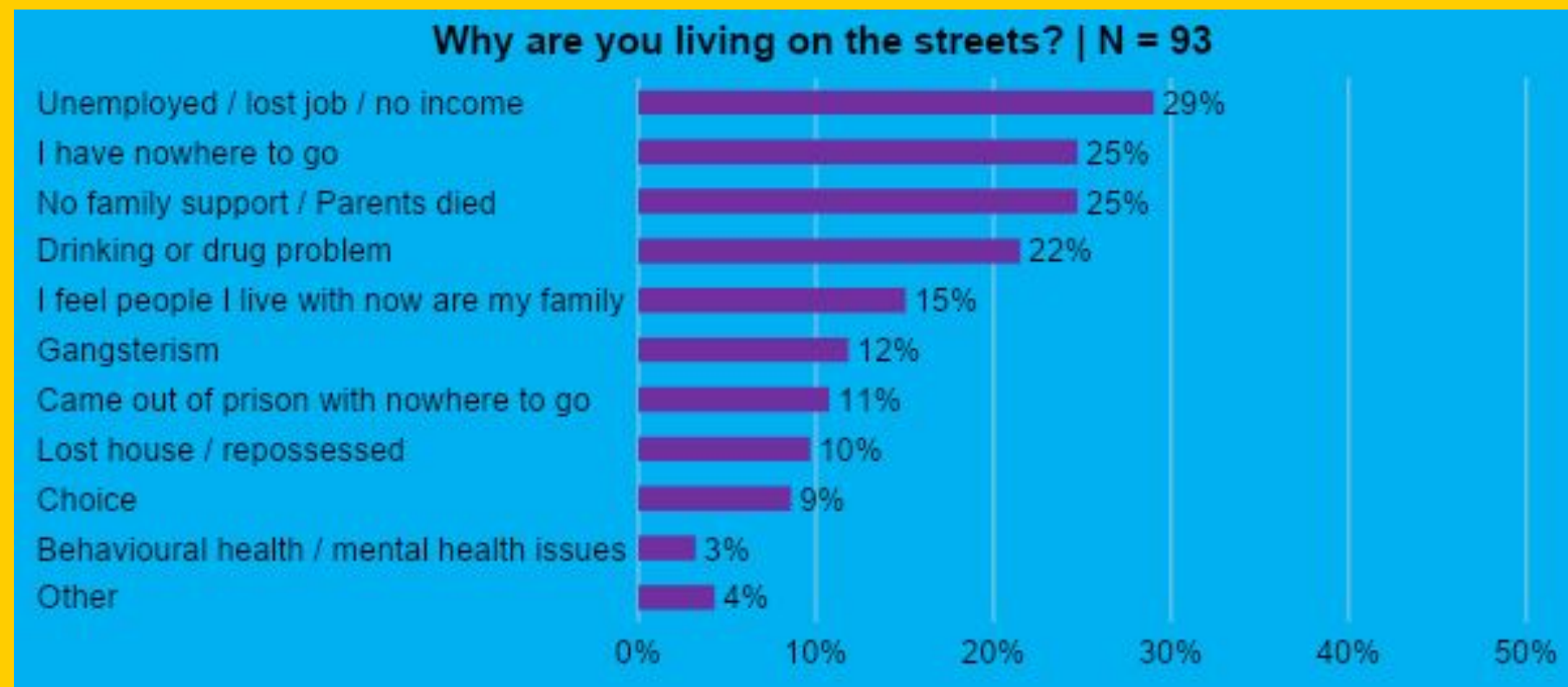
CAUSES OF HOMELESSNESS (WARD 77)

CAUSES OF HOMELESSNESS (WARD 77)

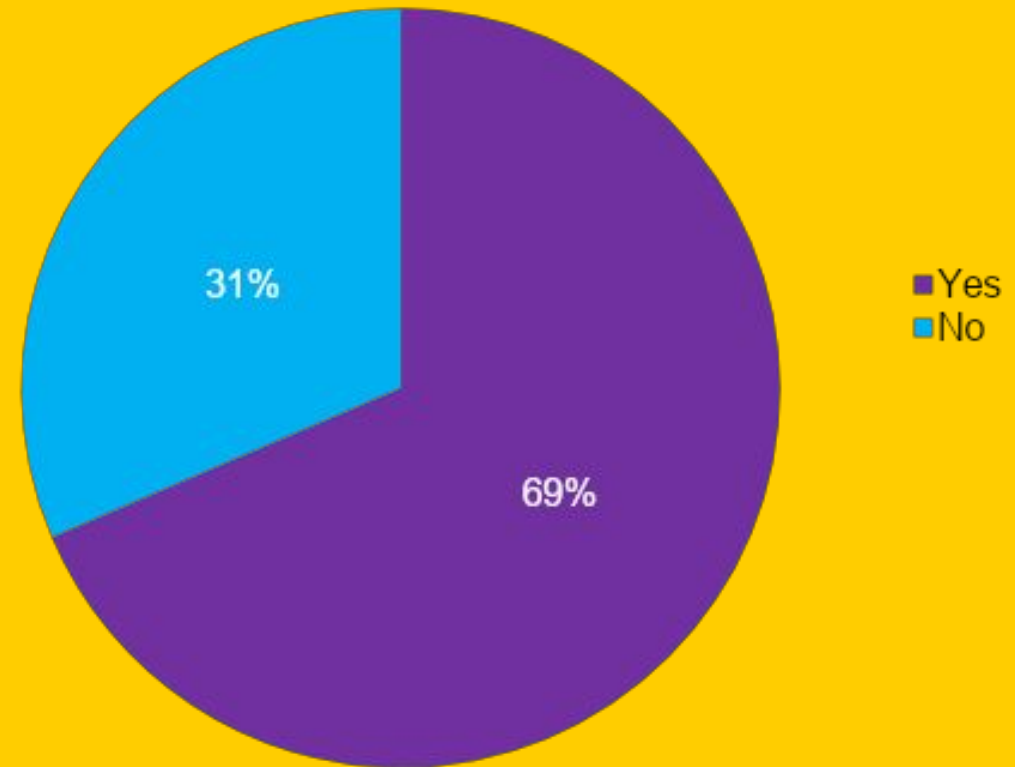
Many respondents had multiple reasons for living on the street.



EXPERIENCES OF CRIME

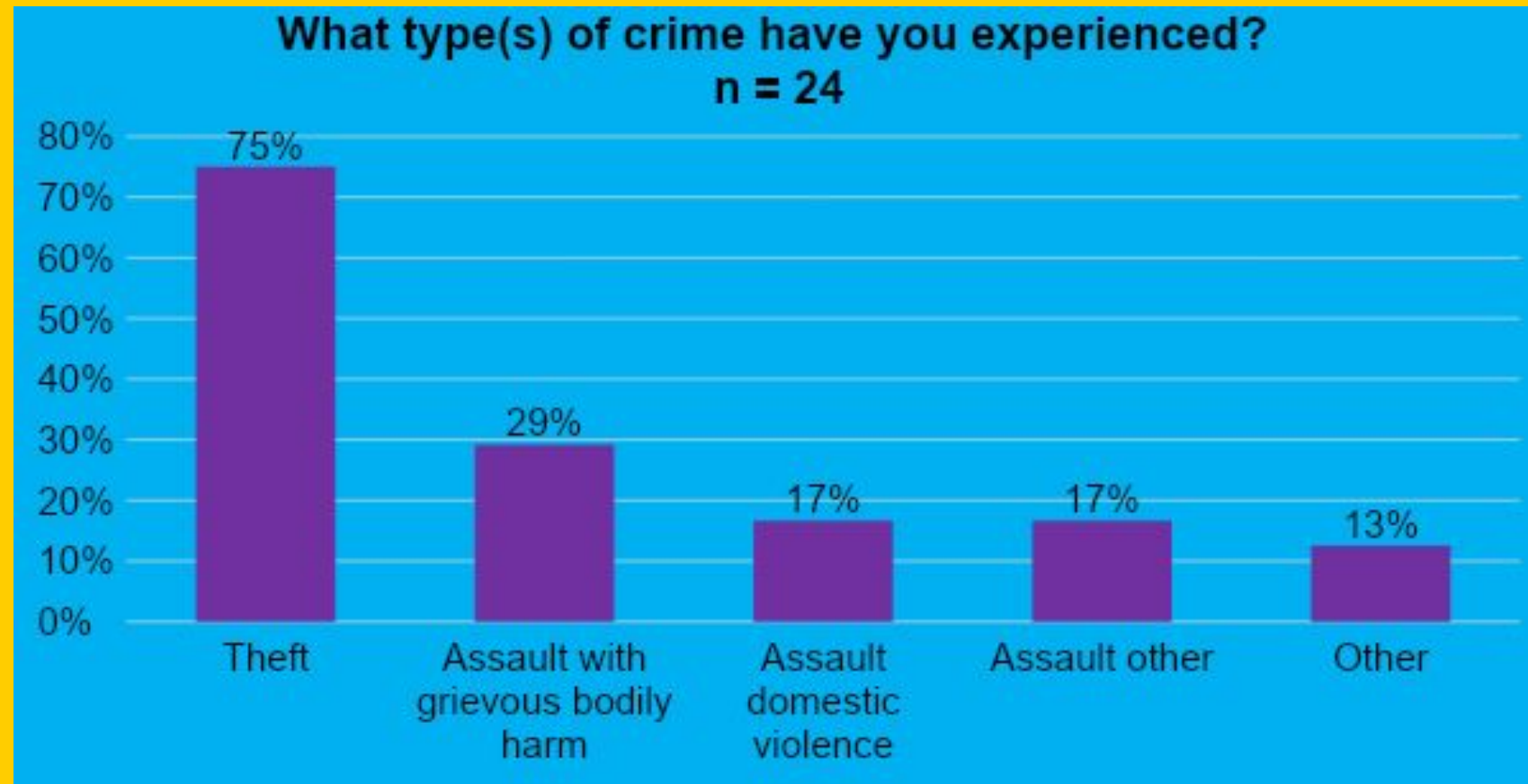
Most people experiencing homelessness in DPV have been a victim of crime.

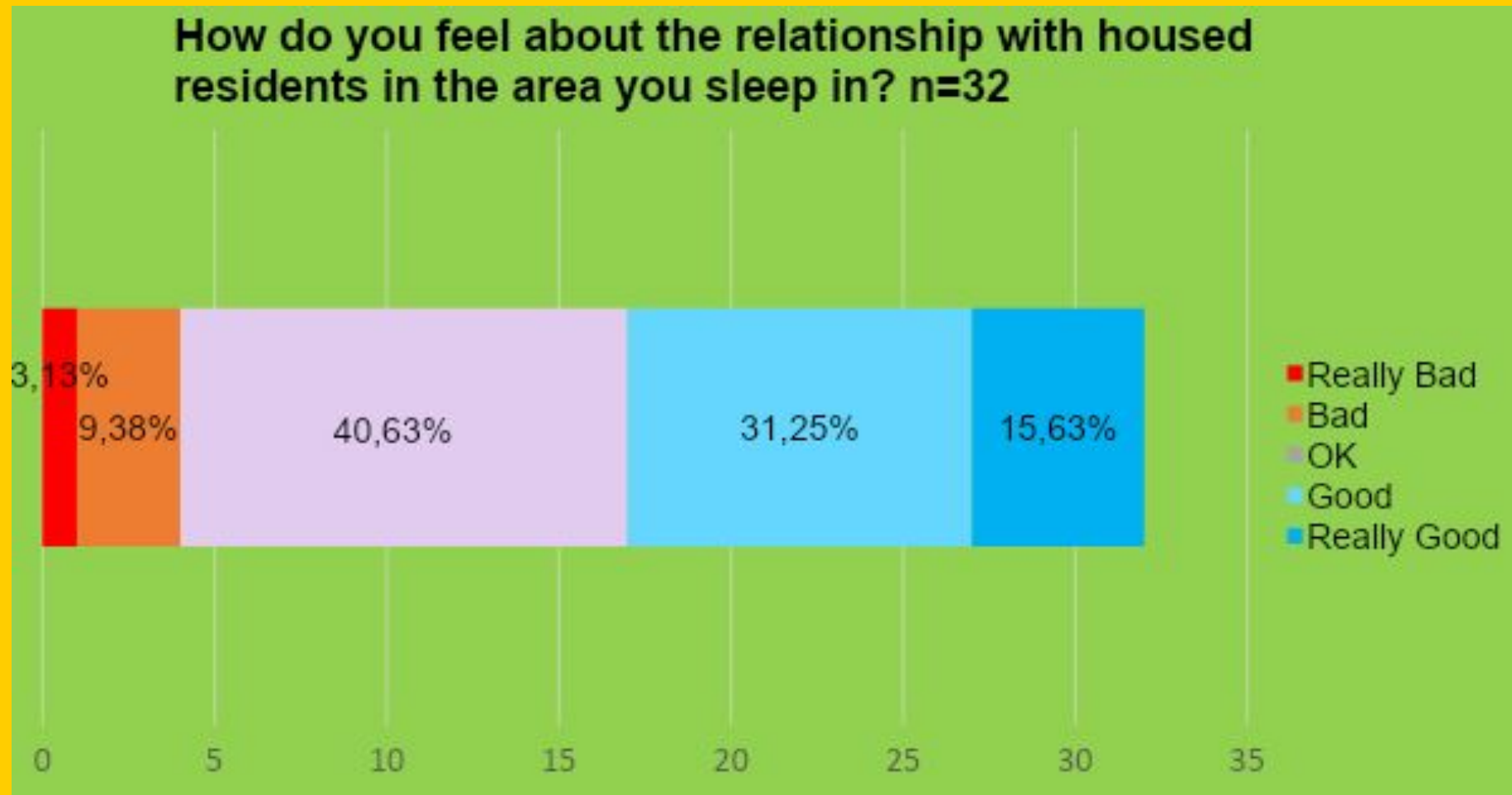
Some respondents experienced multiple types of crime.





RELATIONSHIPS WITH HOUSED DPV NEIGHBOURS

Respondents living in DPV feel mostly 'OK' and 'Good' about their relationships with housed DPV residents.



RELATIONSHIPS WITH HOUSED DPV NEIGHBOURS

Good experiences with housed residents:

- Donations of food and other items
- Employment opportunities
- Church
- Other types assistance

Bad experiences with housed residents:

- Calling the police
- Rudeness
- Toilet challenges

More people shared good experiences than bad.

“They are nice to us.”

“Was invited for lunch once.”

*“They always ask not to toilet every
where.”*

“Socializing and understanding”

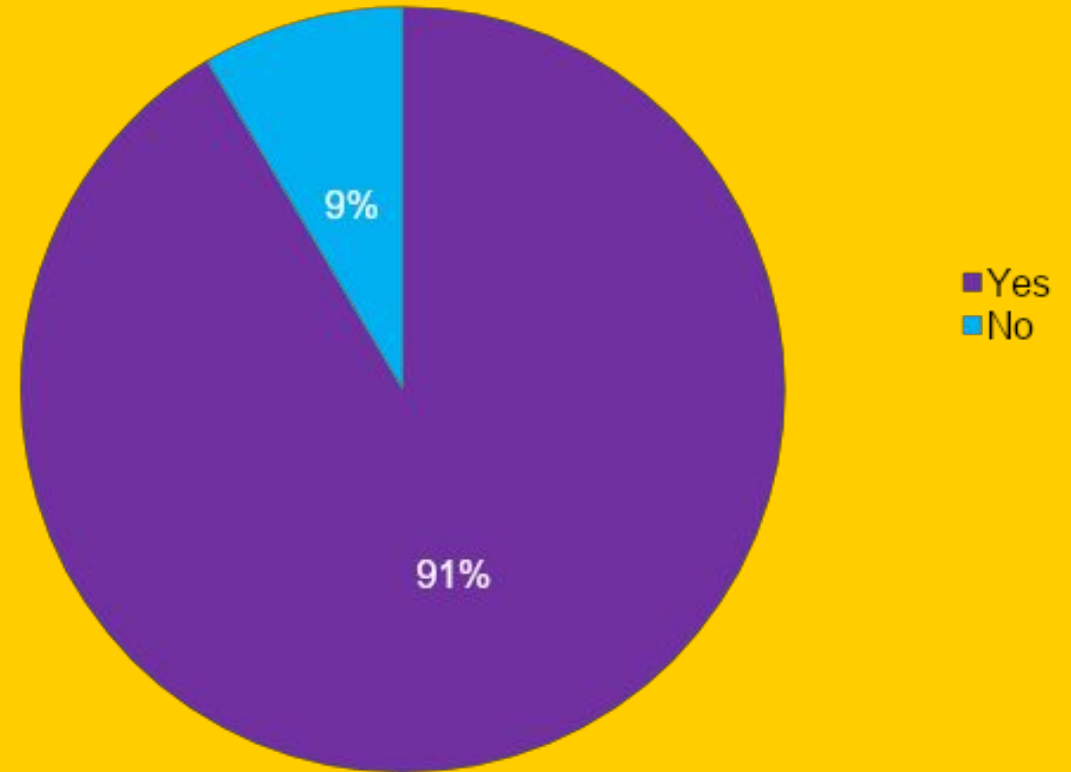

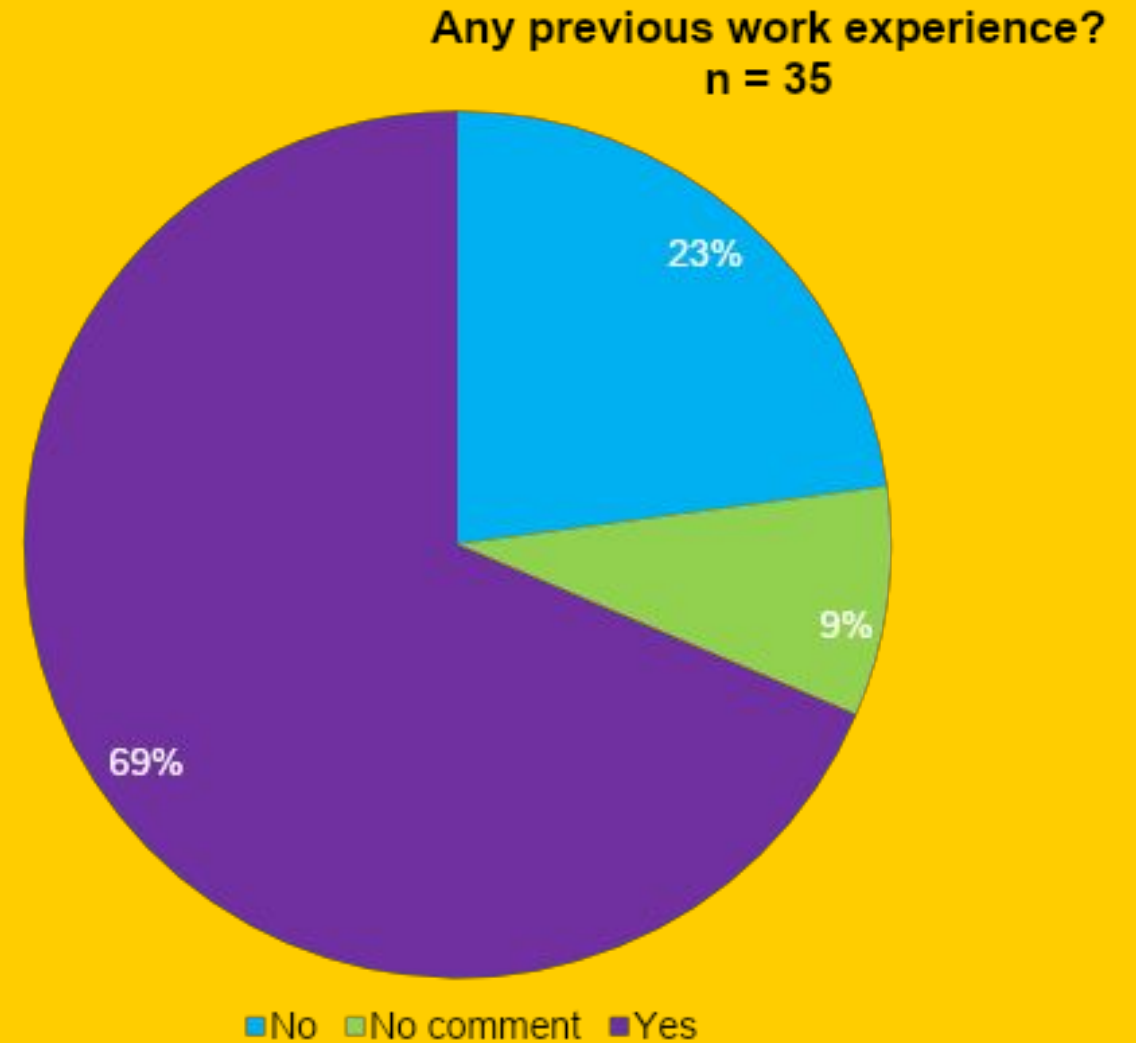


EMPLOYMENT

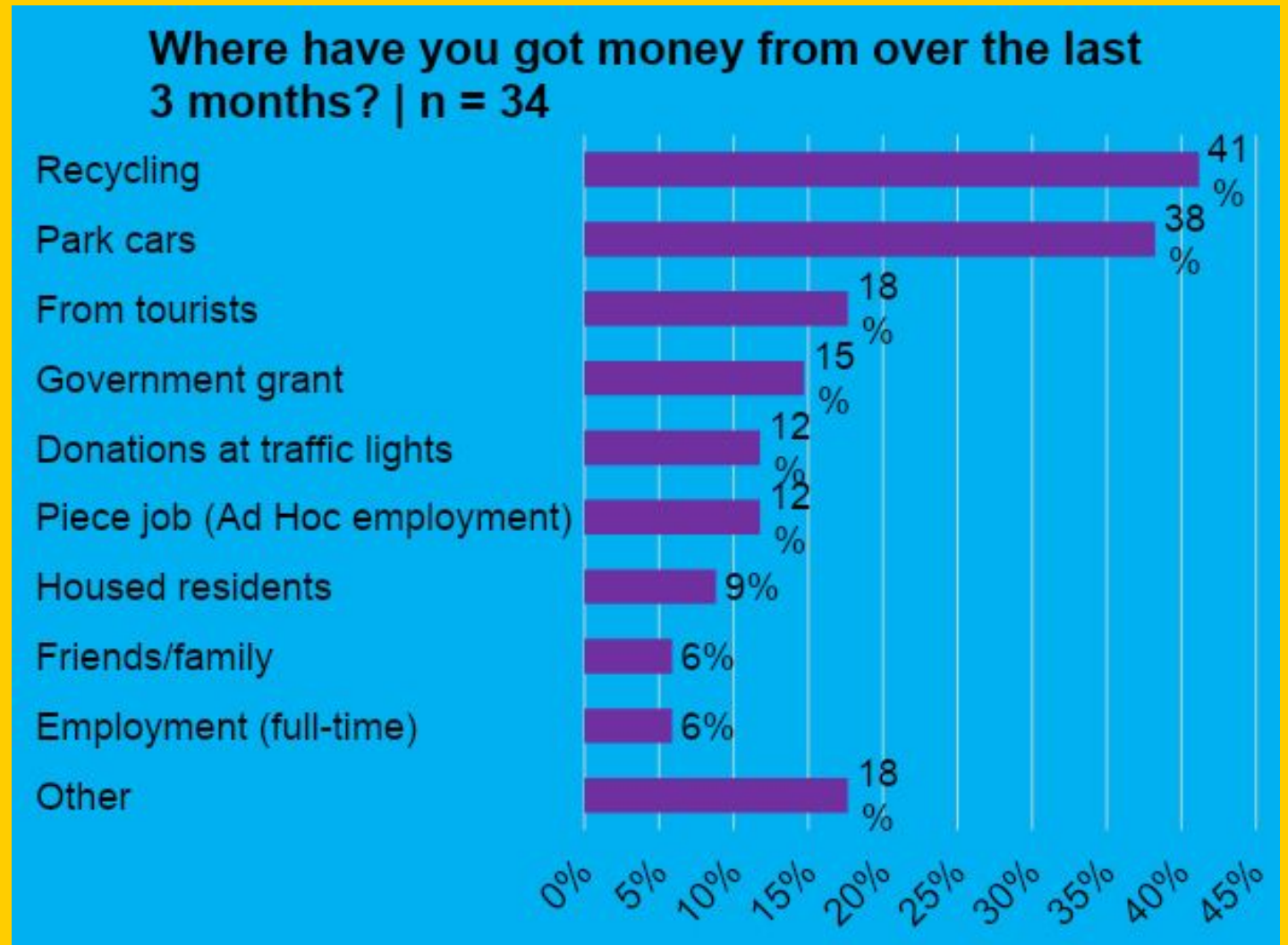
Length of previous employment:

“Other” responses included one person who did artwork.



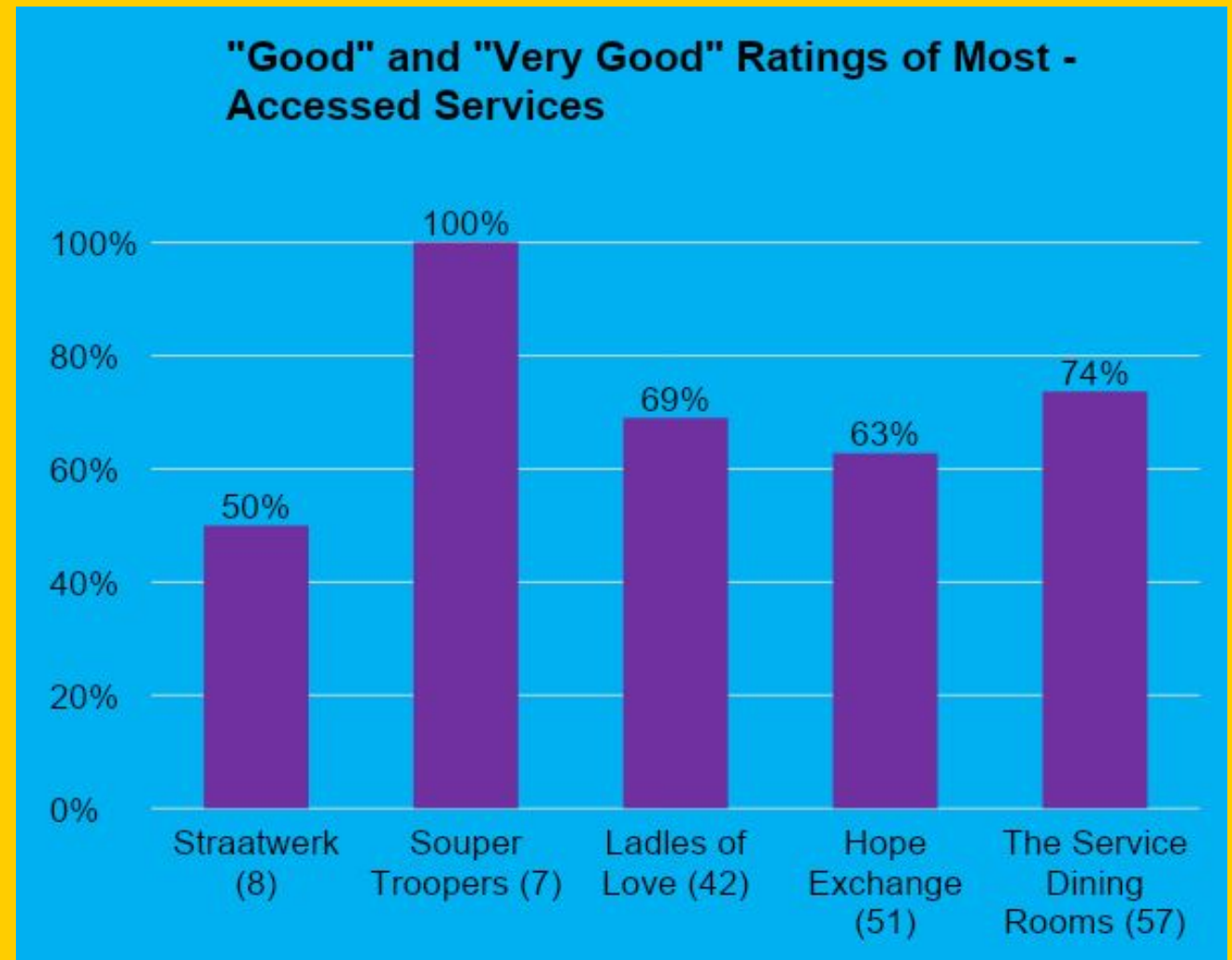
SERVICES
