FACTUAL REPORT: DEATH IN CUSTODY: TABLE VIEW SAPS: CAS 102/11/2023 INQUEST ON 2023/11/06 AT 01:30

1. On 2023-11-05 at 23:45 SAPS members of the Table View SAPS, crime prevention unit (CPU) were busy with patrols at Marine Drive Close, Table View, at the information centre. The SAPS members noticed two African males coming out of the dark. The two African males were called by the SAPS members and they ignored the members.
2. The members chased after the two African males. Both were apprehended. The SAPS members found an unlicensed firearm with 14 rounds of ammunition in possession of one of the African males. The African male found with the firearm, identified himself as Isaac Manpane, 44 years old. During the arrest the second African male refused to cooperate and SAPS members used the force necessary to place the person into the back of the patrol vehicle.
3. On 2023-11-06 at 00:15 the SAPS members detained and processed the two African males at Table View SAPS on CAS 101/11/2023 Possession of Prohibited Firearm, Illegal Possession of Ammunition. The second African male identified himself as Given Mbusela with date of birth 1977-04-11 and 46 years old. It is alleged that during the processing Given Mbusela refused that his shoelaces be removed, whereby in the process the members were attacked by Given Mbusela. It is further alleged that the person in custody Given Mbusela sustained a head injury during the struggle to cooperate.
4. The person in custody later struggled with breathing and the SAPS members who arrested Given Mbusela was instructed to arrange for medical assistance. The SAPS members then took Given Mbusela from the cell facility and placed him in the back of the marked police patrol vehicle. On arrival at De Noon Clinic the person in custody was put on a ventilator and was declared by the medical practitioner as Death on Arrival. An Inquest was registered CAS 102/11/2023 as reference.
5. IPID investigator Estree was contacted to give attention to the incident. During the investigation the address of the deceased person in custody was established, 241 Eden on the Bay, C-Block, Table

6. On 2023-11-06 at 10:20 the address was visited by the Col J Alcock, Captain Smith, Captain Chandler, Sgt Madebuka and Victim Support Trauma Councilor Craig. The visit to the address was to locate the next of Kin of the deceased person. Zanele Nzamo contact details 0608102847 was found at the address and indicated that she was the girlfriend of the deceased.
7. Details of the sister of the deceased was also provided namely Tumi Phenyoo with contact details 0791525696 and residing in Pretoria. The deceased mother of his child was also located, Mesinah Moorosi with contact details 072 926 9283 and details of son Tsego Fatso Peete and 18 years old.
8. All of the abovementioned family of the deceased was informed of the investigation and to make contact with IPID investigator Estree on number 064 663 1897 for further information with regard to the investigation.
9. The SAPS members identified was provided EHW assistance by WO Solomons (Pastor) on 2023-11-06. Members were also explained of the right to remain silent as well as the right to legal representation. The girlfriend received Trauma Counselling during the visit to the address. All role-players were utilized to give attention to the incident of death in custody at Table View SAPS. IPID Reference: WC 10/11/2023/0221/SM. The investigation still continues.
